GOALS OF THE PARTNERSHIP

- 1. Ensure that appropriate clients are referred to the buildings.
- 2. Ensure that tenants have the support they need to maintain successful tenancy
- 3. Ensure that early identification of individual tenant needs leads to i) a reduction in social isolation, ii) opportunities for assuming leadership roles and iii) greater involvement in the decisions that affect tenants within their 'home' and community.
- 4. Create more affordable supportive housing

LEAD AGENCY – ALL-TOGETHER HOUSING

- Provides leadership and motivation to the Partnership toward meeting the goals set out in the Partnership Agreement.
- 2. Acts as employer for the Partnership Co-ordinator responsible for supervision, evaluation, training opportunities and payroll.

PARTNERSHIP CO-ORDINATOR

- Fosters positive collaborative relations among all parties to the Partnership
- Provides leadership to identify subjects which require clear written policies; arrange collaboration of Partners to ensure such policies are developed and implemented.

32 Units – mix of affordable (17) and market rent (15) units

Energy and Accessibility Features exceed Building Code

Affordable Rents 20-30% below CMHC Average Market Rent

COMMON SPACE

10 Fully Accessible units
22 Visitable units
Full sized elevator
Wide hallways and doors
Turning space at the end and middle of each hallway
Accessible common room
Universal washroom
Accessible Laundry room
Wide doorway into Garbage room, Meeting room and Office

KITCHEN

Lower counter tops 34" vs standard 36". Open space under the counter, sink and cooktop. Wall mounted oven. Accessible outlets. Accessible lever faucet. Raised toe kick space Accessible appliances

BATHROOM

Large turning radius. Transfer space beside toilet. Transfer space beside shower. Shower with low threshold and seat. Accessible shower controls and handheld shower head. Space under the sink Accessible lever faucet Grab bars by the toilet and in the shower
