## The Corporation of the City Of Quinte West By-Law Number 23-120

Being A By-law To Amend By-law 23-001, Being A By-law To Govern The Calling, Place And Proceedings Of Meetings Of The Council Of The Corporation Of The City Of Quinte West.

**Whereas** Section 238(2) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that every council and local board shall adopt a procedure by-law for governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;

**And Whereas** Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a Council may pass By-laws for governing their affairs as they consider appropriate;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Quinte West desires to limit public input at Council and Committee meetings to matters related to City business;

Now Therefore Be It Enacted By the Council For The Corporation Of The City Of Quinte West As Follows:

- This By-law shall be entitled the "2023 Procedural By-law Amendment No. 02".
- 2. That Section 4. n. of By-law 23-001 be amended by removing (g) and replacing it with the following:
  - (g) "In the "Public Input" section of the Agenda, persons are permitted to speak on issues related to the business of the City and that public input be limited to three (3) minutes. Public Input is for the receipt of information by Council or Committee only. Questions may not be directed to Council or Committee for debate, nor shall any of the items raised be debated by members of Council or Committee during this portion of the Agenda;"
- 3. This By-law shall take effect on the final date of passing.
