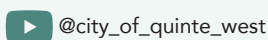
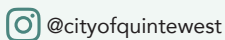
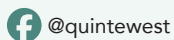

# PARKS AND PLAY:

## OUTDOOR RECREATION IN QUINTE WEST



**Quinte West offers the perfect mix of parks, trails and amenities across all four wards.**

### TRENTON

Trenton is home to multiple trails and parks. The Millennium Trail runs alongside the Trent Port Marina, offering beautiful views of the Bay of Quinte and is ideal for walking, cycling or wheelchairs, and is accessible for all.

**Hanna Park** is great for a nature escape, featuring 42-acres with marked trails, tennis courts, a children's play area and an off-leash dog park.

**Centennial Park** in Trenton is a must-visit with a splash pad, skate park, sports fields and the Trenton Lions Inclusive Playground, designed for children of all abilities. Starting at the Pop-ups is a circular waterfront trail that winds through the park along the shores of the Bay of Quinte.

Other parks of interest include **Bain Park**, which is located close to CFB Trenton and features views of the Bay of Quinte, sports fields, and the Afghanistan Repatriation Memorial. **Fraser Park** in downtown Trenton features beautiful gardens and the Ted Snider Bandshell where local performances take place during the summer.

## FRANKFORD

Enjoy views of the Trent River at **Frankford Tourist Park and Campground**. With a playground, skate park, beach and tranquil views, it's a hub for outdoor fun and relaxation. Only a short distance away is the **Frankford Splash Park**.

Located in Frankford, along North Trent Street is **Bata Island**, where a walkway leads into the mostly forested park, with trails splitting off a loop of the island.

# A CITY OF TRAILS

**The City of Quinte West has diverse trail experiences for nature lovers and outdoor enthusiasts.**

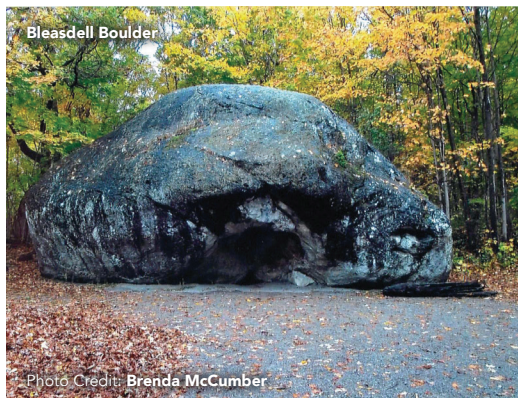
Visit the **Bleasdel Boulder Conservation Area** and hike the 1.5 km trail for a glimpse of one of North America's largest glacial erratics. With a difficulty level of "easy", this trail is great for the whole family. Other easy trails include those at **Trenton Greenbelt Conservation Area** and **South Potter's Creek Conservation Area**.

**North Potter's Creek Conservation Area** contains a mixture of meadows, forests and orchards where you can explore both an easy 4.6 km and the more intermediate 2.7 km trail. Additionally, **Sidney Conservation Area** located in the Oak Hills area also has 1.6 km of intermediate level trails for you to experience.

For a more challenging hike, visit **Sager Conservation Area** where you climb a half kilometre incline before arriving at a tower.

The climb is worth it as the top of the tower provides a breathtaking panoramic view of the countryside. For another hiking experience, visit **Mount Pelion**, accessed off of MacLellan Avenue in Trenton to view the City's urban core and the Bay of Quinte.

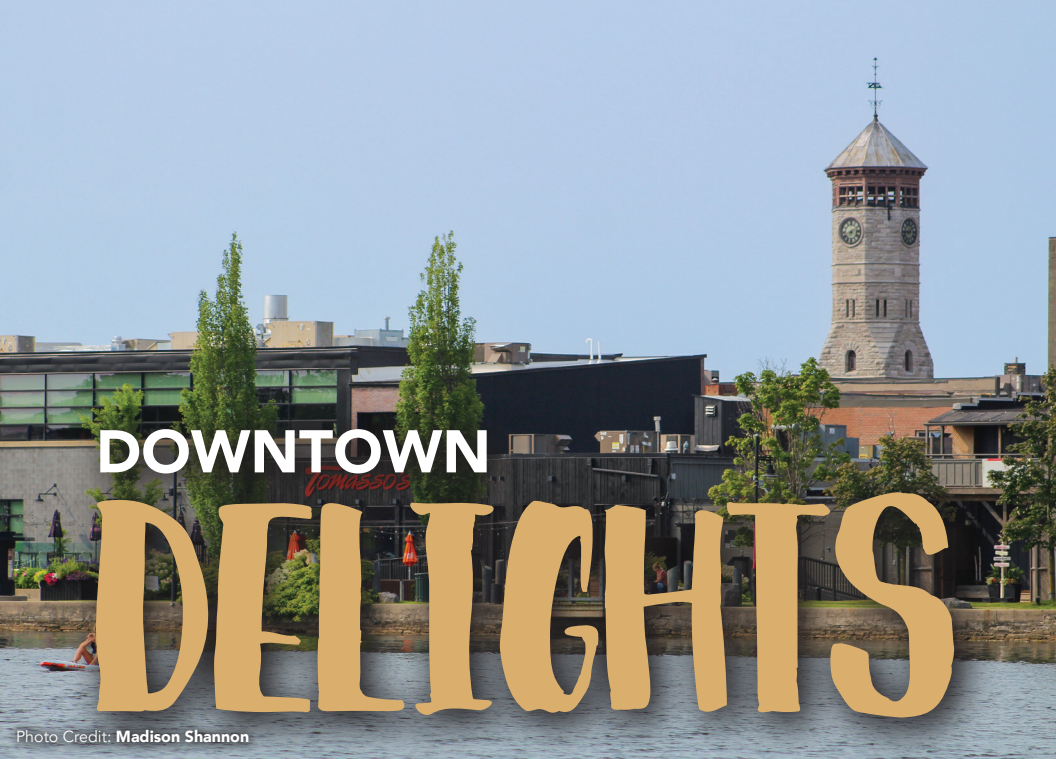
## STAY HYDRATED AND GET MOVING ON BATAWA'S TRAILS

## CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

### TRENTON TOWN HALL - 1861

Home of the Trent Port Historical Society, the Trenton Town Hall 1861 is one of Quinte West's most noticeable landmarks. Established as a multi-purpose building, the Trenton Town Hall served as a space for municipal offices, a police station, a courtroom and a farmers' market. In 1981, the Trent Port Historical Society was established to preserve the history of Trenton through photographs, documents and artifacts. With the formation of Quinte West (from the amalgamation of the Trenton, Sidney, Frankford and Murray wards), the scope of preservation expanded. Moving into the digital age, the Trent Port Historical Society is modernizing its collection records with the capability to share the information with any interested party in the community and beyond.

The building is not open to the public; however, events are posted on their website and Facebook page, and tours can be made by appointment.

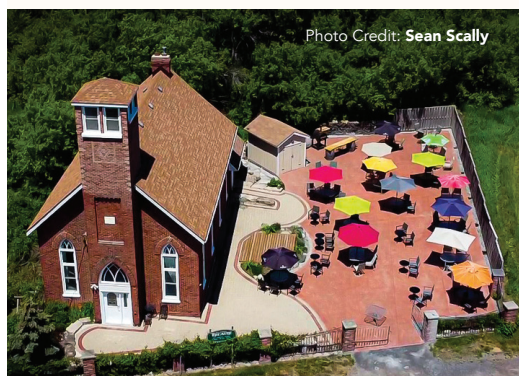
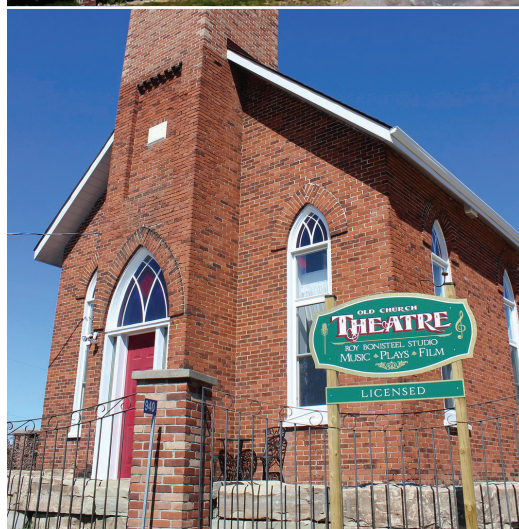

Doors Open returns on Saturday, Oct. 3, 2026, from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. at various sites throughout Quinte West.

Hosted by the City of Quinte West in partnership with the Ontario Heritage Trust, Doors Open Quinte West offers visitors the opportunity to visit and tour sites, many of which are not regularly open to the public that showcase the history, architecture and cultural diversity of Quinte West. The provincial Doors Open program was launched in 2002 to create access, awareness and excitement about the province's heritage, providing unique opportunities to explore and enjoy some of the most interesting places in Ontario cities, towns and villages.

*A CONVERSATION WITH LOCAL ARTIST ANGELA SMYLIE*

Artist Angela Smylie has always found creative expression in many forms, from drawing and sewing to music and textile arts. Her journey into painting began in 2019 while co-leading the Unplugged program for girls at St. George's Anglican Church in Trenton, where a visit from local artist Lori Meeboer inspired her to pick up a brush.

Along the side of Napa Auto Parts, take in the views of the mural that celebrates the **evolution of the bridges** connecting both sides of Quinte West over the Trent River.

On the side of Centre Cinemas, a beautiful new mural showcases the **history of Hollywood North**, a nickname Trenton earned in the early 1900s at the height of the silent film industry.

**120 Dundas St. W, Trenton**

Behind 2 King St in Trenton, a mural commemorates the **Farmers' Market of the 1800s**. Painted in 1995 by Stephen Snider, it was commissioned by the Trenton DBIA and sponsored by Trenval. Still standing, the site of Trenton Town Hall-1861 at 55 King St is visible nearby. Turn 180 degrees to see another mural by Christopher Bennett of SERNA Custom Artwork, commissioned by ABC Taxi.

With a minimum of two curated installations per year featuring artists from the Bay of Quinte, these eight double-sided structures show Quinte West's dedication to supporting and showcasing the region's arts community.
